East Lake Community School is a single classroom site for students who excel in a smaller, supportive and structured environment.

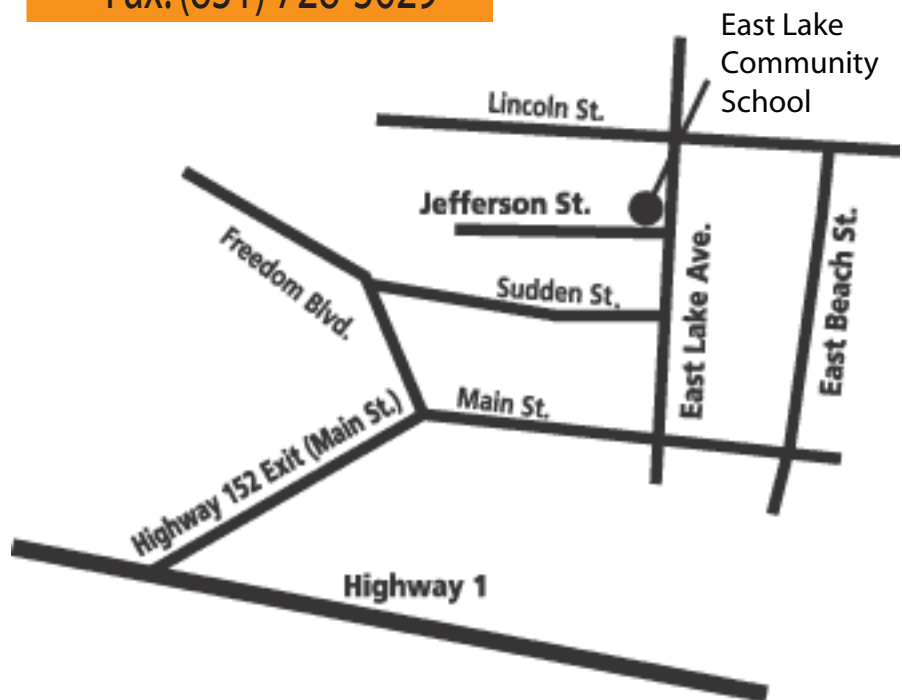
