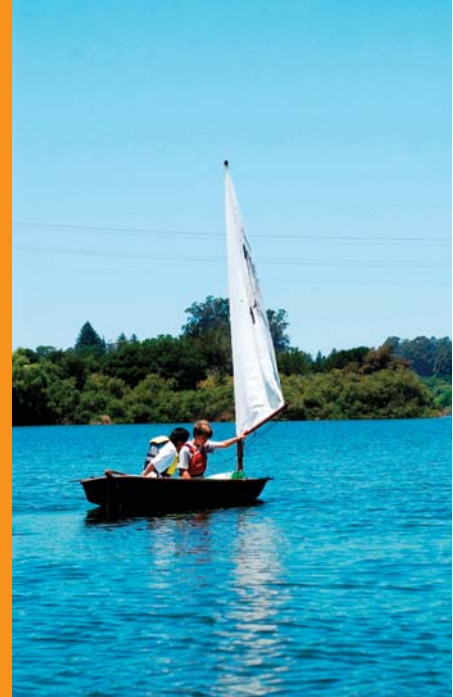
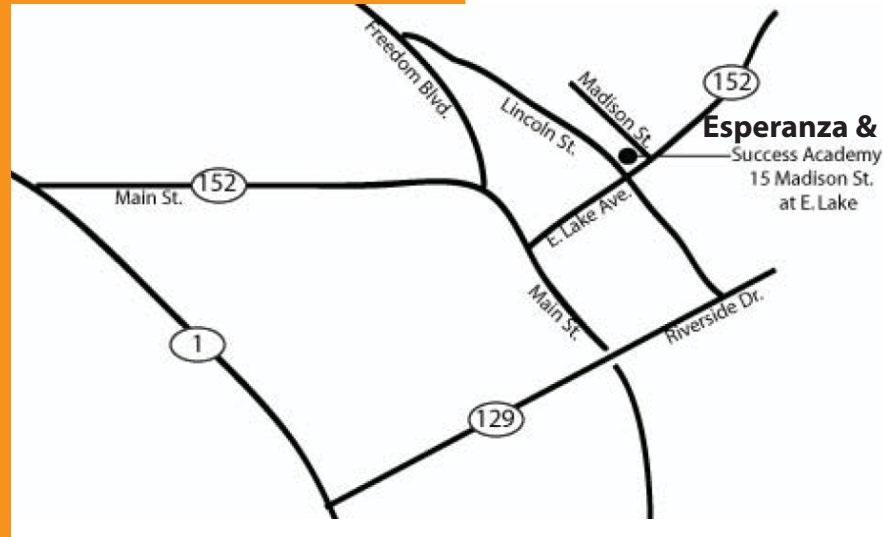


# Esperanza Middle School
