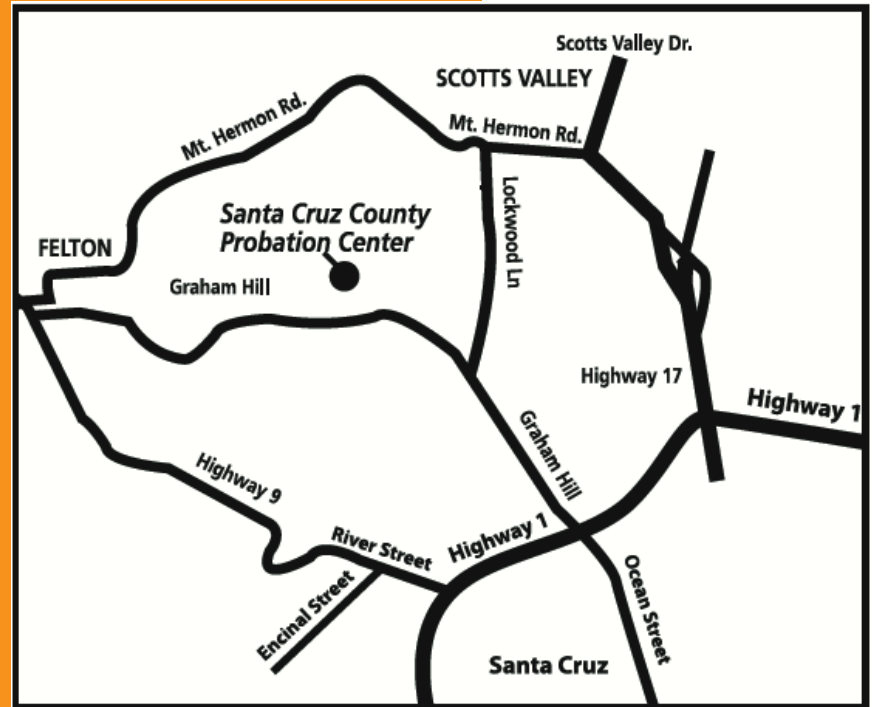


Robert A. Hartman School
