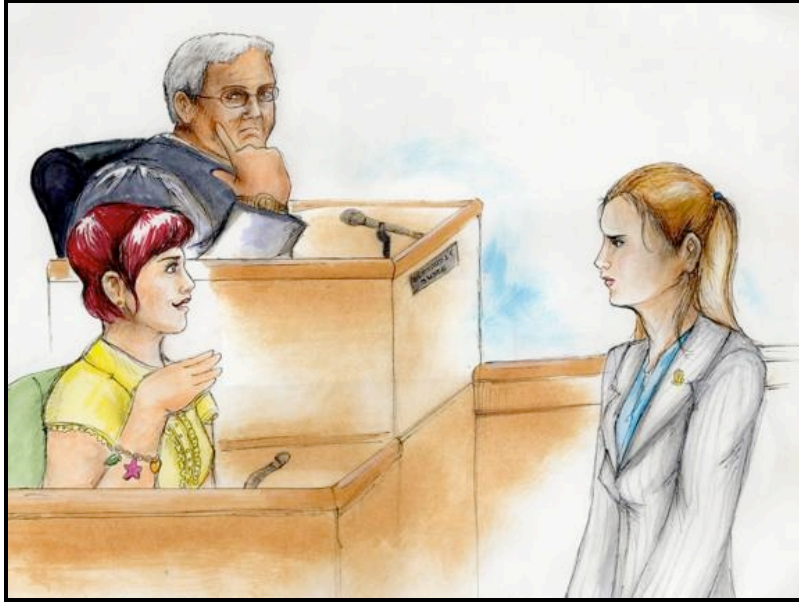


Attention All Attorneys and Judges!
